After a GP proxy battle of the Boca Raton Hotel and Club Partnership, initiated on behalf of the existing partnership a successful debt reduction/refinancing and commenced a \$50 million plus expansion to include a conference center, state of the art Tennis and Fitness Center, 18-hole golf course, and parking facility which eventually resulted in a successful sale of \$320 million. 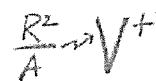

Please List Areas of Special Interest:	I am particularly interested in accumulating data in order to make our START system more effective for our residents, commuters, and visitors. We need to reach beyond ridership data in order to increase public access for users for whom the system is not operating efficiently. I would reach out directly into the local business community to gather this data. (I already have nearly 300 surveys filled out by local businesses.) I would also work with START to figure out a way to collect "off-ridership" data, as currently we only have the activity of getting on the bus as a data point. In order to understand the real functionality of the system, it is important to have both the getting on and getting off events captured.
Please provide your knowledge of the duties & responsibilities of the Board you are applying for:	I recognize the role of the Board as a conduit between the County Commission, the Town Council, and the START Department. I also believe that the Board should be responsive to public comment and desires, providing another avenue for the public to access officials who direct policy for our public transit options. As you may know, I have already been involved conducting surveys, developing incentive structures, and organizing the downtown businesses in order to affect our employee's behaviors. I would relish the opportunity to work within the START system to further these efforts. I am deeply committed to increasing options for riders and even providing incentives for employees who work in and around the

downtown area to utilize a transit system designed to serve their needs.

Why do you want to serve on this Board?

I believe that the START system can serve the areas of density in and around the Town Square much more effectively at very little (or no) cost to the taxpayers. Tweaking the schedules so that buses arrive at the three stops servicing the Town Square, the Town and County Admin buildings, and the Hospital just before the turn of the hour in the mornings and leave those same areas of density just after the hour in the afternoons could have a massive impact on all of our lines. The goal is to match the START schedule to the needs of potential users; this is a much more effective strategy for increasing ridership than sticking to schedules that ignore the needs of employees who work in areas of density. Also, we should experiment with a consistent, efficient service that leaves the Stilson Lot at 40 minutes after the hour every hour in the morning and runs express to the Town Square, Admin buildings, and hospital before returning to its regular green line route. I have worked out schedules so that these express buses will simply run within the context of the regular winter bus schedule. I'd love to get this experiment running in time for winter.

What are your qualifications for serving on this Board?

I've will bring a good mix of traits, relationships, and experiences to the Board. I am solution-oriented and am driven to find solutions to the traffic problems of Teton County. I strongly believe that through schedule adjustments and the establishment of an express line from Stilson, we can dramatically increase options for our residents and commuters. I strongly believe that we live in a community which values the Vision of the Comp Plan that we must reduce the number of Single Occupancy Vehicles on our roads. Further, the constant congestion in the summer months should encourage more riders to use our START system once we make give them better options. On top of this, I organized a number of businesses to participate in the Downtown Parking Incentive Program for two months at the end of this summer. I developed a system and a website to handle usage for thousands of users and hundreds of businesses while collecting survey data on employees in the process. Additionally, the program developed a number of tiers for businesses with varying degrees of commitment/interest and a number of prizes for the participants. The key to the program was getting businesses to sponsor the incentives themselves, as they contributed directly to their employees incentives. I would love to expand this program this winter in order to create more opportunity to change behaviors, but first we must work to orient START to servicing town employees by giving them more reasonable options than currently exist.

What experience and/or special training do you have that is pertinent to this Board's efforts?

I have worked tirelessly with downtown managers and owners on a multitude of projects ranging from trash and recycling collection, to parking, to bag bans, and to START. I have put my time, sweat, and dollars into developing solutions that will work to actually reduce the number of SOVs on our overcrowded roads. Our Comp Plan demands that we work toward solutions to reduce SOVs, and I believe that this charge can only be

realized by utilizing START to its full capacity. Having spent the better part of a year studying the START system, riding the lines, speaking with staff, drivers, and riders, considering various scheduling options, and surveying riders and non-riders, I've been surprised by the amount of low-hanging fruit available to the Town and County if we can provide some better direction to the START Department.

What is your understanding of the time and service requirements of this Board and how are you prepared to meet them?

As a candidate for the County Commission, I was ready to commit up to 40 hours/week to civic service. I would be glad to commit 10-20 hours/week to work as a member of the START Board. I will be an active and engaged member, dedicating my time and energy to both planning and boots on the ground interaction with the community, especially the business community. I have developed relationships with dozens of my fellow business owners, and although we don't always see eye to eye, I think I have most if not all of their respect. I would love the opportunity to operate on a more institutional platform as opposed to trying to implement my ideas from outside of government.

Do you have any scheduling conflicts you are aware of?

Although I own two toy stores and software company, they are all fairly self-sufficient and becoming more so by the year. If you saw me during the recent campaign, I hope that you can vouch for my level of interest and commitment to finding solutions for our transit services. I am sorry for the lateness of my application. I have been really busy over the past couple of months, as I've been occupied with a run for County Commissioner and catching up with my businesses over the past couple of weeks (with Christmas quickly approaching). I have not asked for references for the reason that I am filling this application out too late to ask. The task of overseeing the administration of the Jackson Airport is complex and requires a holistic approach and deft balance to deliver the best possible results for impacted parties. Greg Herrick

Greg Herrick has been resident of Teton County since 1995. He is an experienced pilot and has been flying since 1969. He holds the following FAA pilot ratings: Commercial Pilot, Single and Multiengine Land & Sea and Instrument ratings.

Mr. Herrick is also one of the nation's preeminent stewards, preservationists and collectors of Golden Age aircraft and a recognized leader in the aviation community. Among his earlier business accomplishments Mr. Herrick started a computer company ZEOS International Ltd., during his lunch hour, employing more than 1,600 people just five years later. In 1991, ZEOS was named "America's Fastest Growing Public Company" by Fortune magazine. Then, four years later, ZEOS was sold to Micron Technology, Inc. of Boise, Idaho, in a reverse merger.

Recognizing the need to again have two FBOs at the Jackson Hole Airport, in early 2017, Mr. Herrick organized Wyoming Jet Center and applied to re-establish a second FBO at the airport. In the course of this process he has attended the Airport Board meetings and is well versed in the numerous issues addressed by the board over the last two years.

Mr. Herrick is president of the Aviation Foundation of America, Inc. and owner of the catalog publishing company Sky Media of Wyoming, publisher of the *Historic Aviation*, *Historic Rail* and *Military Issue* catalogs. Among many endeavors, the Aviation Foundation of America organized the re-creation of the National Air Tours in 2003 and operates America's largest aviation event focused Web site, www.fly-ins.com. Fly-ins.com posts and promotes thousands of aviation events across the United States each year. The Aviation Foundation promotes and celebrates American aviation heroes and organized the placement of the R.A. "Bob" Hoover Trophy in the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum in Washington, D.C. The Foundation also created the coveted "Bob Hoover" award presented annually to distinguished recipients at a prestigious event in Washington, D.C. Past recipients include Harrison Ford and Sean D. Tucker.

Mr. Herrick is active in national aviation organizations and is well known in the aviation community. As a result of his dedication to preserving America's aviation history and following the successful re-creation of the National Air Tours in 2003 – an official U.S. Centennial of Flight celebration and also known originally as the Ford Air Tours – Herrick was honored with numerous awards and recognitions. These awards include the prestigious "Laurel Award" from Aviation Week & Space Technology.

On behalf of the Ford family, Edsel B. Ford II presented Herrick with the "Spirit of Ford" Award. It was the first time the award had been presented to someone outside of the automobile industry. In 2006 Mr. Herrick was named as one of the "Living Legends of Aviation" at an annual event at the Hollywood Bowl. It is considered "the Oscars of Aviation" which recognizes and honors individuals with "great and significant contributions to the field of aviation." Other recipients of this honor, limited to seventy-five living persons, include Sir Richard Branson, Harrison Ford, Gene Cernan, "Sully" Sullenberger and others.

As part of his ongoing service to aviation, Mr. Herrick serves on the Board of Trustees of the National Aviation Hall of Fame, the national EAA Young Eagles council and on the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association national Airport Access Advisory Panel.

Mr. Herrick knows how to get things done for the advancement of aviation. For more than a decade and at his personal expense, Mr. Herrick pursued an effort to preserve and make available historic FAA Approved Type Certificate application packages, including the original drawings, testing and construction data – in other words, our nation's "DNA" of aviation. After successfully pursuing the matter to the United States Supreme Court, Mr. Herrick approached the U.S. Congress to make the issue a matter of U.S. law. This occurred with the passing of the FAA Air Transportation Modernization and Safety Improvement Act 2012 (HR 658). The amendment was labeled by its congressional sponsors as "*The Herrick Amendment*."

In another decade long project, Mr. Herrick successfully prevailed in a project to remanufacture ground adjustable metal propeller blades and their hubs which are critical for the safe operation of many vintage aircraft. This involved considerable research and persuasion of propeller manufacturer MT Propeller of Germany to recertificate and manufacture the new blades. This culminated in 2012 with the FAA certification of the new hubs and blades for use in Standard Category aircraft significantly increasing the safe operations of vintage aircraft using these propellers.

Mr. Herrick's collection of 40 rare, Golden Age aircraft is maintained in a 55,000 square-foot hangar. Without Mr. Herrick's research and restoration, these aircraft would have been lost to history. Mr. Herrick and the collection have been the subject of numerous features in magazine such as *Forbes* and *Air & Space*. He has appeared on radio and television stations across the country such as *Discovery Wings*, PRI's "*Savvy Traveler*," Voice of America Radio and CBS Radio. He also has appeared in international magazines and in hundreds of major daily newspapers. The airplanes are kept in flying condition and are flown by experienced aviators including Mr. Herrick.

Mr. Herrick has been recognized by the publishers of the Marquis "Who's Who" directories and is listed in *Who's Who In The World*, *Who's Who In America*, *Who's Who In Business and Finance* as well as *Who's Who In Science and Engineering*.

Mr. Herrick was born on November 23, 1951, in Iowa, son of Dr. Walter Edward Herrick and Doris Ann [Evans] Herrick. His first pilot's lesson was in November of 1969 and he was granted his Private Pilot's license two months later. He attended the University of Iowa, graduating in 1974 with a degree in <INSERT>.

In 2007 Greg and Suzanne Fedoruk were married in wedding celebration held in the front yard of their home in Jackson Hole.

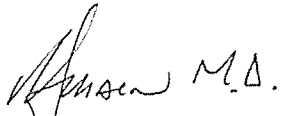

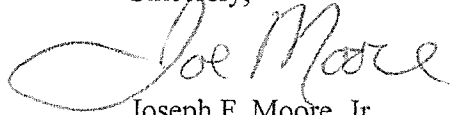

What are your qualifications for serving on this Board? I care. I live here, and have kept residency since 1987 while serving for 11~ years in Washington DC for the Departments of Ag and Interior. I have worked in aviation since 1978 working national emergency incidents.. While in DC, I was the Director of Capital Investment for DOI with a budget of \$1.25 billion. I understand politics, policy, money and managing projects. I

increased DOI's CI budget by \$500k (like it or not) due to capital planning during a 10% reduction period. I know the playing field. Since retiring in 2009, I've worked seasonally for SkyWest at the airport just to keep busy with something i love. I was the first and only employee asked to work in SkyWest Operations due to my knowledge. I will resign if appointed to the board. I have no conflicts - just knowledge and ideas. I also have my own consulting business working as a sub-contractor for Aeromedix.com (local business) and PhaseOneConsulting (DC).

I know quite a bit of the inner workings of the Airport top to bottom thru my past 6 years -- everything from Jeds, to TSA, to commercial airlines, to fuelers, to airport operations... you name it. 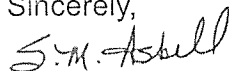
