

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

JUNE 25, 2019

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in special session in the Town Council Chambers located at in Town Hall at 150 East Pearl Avenue at 4:30 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

MAYOR: Pete Muldoon.

COUNCIL: Arne Jorgensen, and Jim Stanford. Jonathan Schechter and Hailey Morton Levinson were absent.

STAFF: Larry Pardee, Lea Colasuonno, Todd Smith, and Sandy Birdyshaw.

Ordinance Readings. A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jim Stanford to read ordinances in short title. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Ordinance C: An Ordinance Repealing Town of Jackson Municipal Code Section 5.12.070 related to Criminal Background Investigations on License or Permit Applications

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 13 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 148, SECTION 5 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 670, SECTION 6 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 860, AND SECTION 1 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 994, AND SECTION 5.12.070 OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON MUNICIPAL CODE WHICH PROVIDES FOR CRIMINAL BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS ON LICENSE OR PERMIT APPLICATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 6 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 860 AND SECTION 5.12.150 OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON MUNICIPAL CODE WHICH PROVIDES FOR PROHIBITIONS AGAINST MERCHANDISE SALES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 1 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 675, SECTION 13 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 860, AND SECTION 5.52.030 OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON MUNICIPAL CODE WHICH PROVIDES FOR HANDBILL DISTRIBUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Pete Muldoon to approve Ordinance F on second reading. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed 2-1 in favor with Stanford opposed. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jim Stanford to adjourn to executive session to consider matters concerning litigation to which the governing body is a party or proposed litigation to which the governing body may be a party in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(iii).
