

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

NOVEMBER 20, 2019

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in a special workshop session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall at 150 East Pearl at 1:30 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Downtown Parking and Mobility Management Plan. Paul Anthony made staff comment on the project timeline.

A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to continue this item to the next available meeting. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.
