

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

JANUARY 22, 2019

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall at 150 East Pearl at 3:00 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

MAYOR: Pete Muldoon

Mayor Muldoon introduced new Town employees Bill Knight and Pablo Vazquez, START Bus Teton Valley Commuter drivers.

Identification Compliance Check Failures at Flat Creek Development Company. Sandy Birdyshaw and Chief Smith and made staff comment on the non-compliance of Jackson Municipal Code liquor regulations.

Judy Peters, Operations Manager, of the Virginian Tavern made comment. Public comment was given by: Mike Kraft, retired manager of the Virginian; Frank Hess, attorney representing the Virginian; Nick Coca, Virginian guest services manager; Steven McNeill Watson, a member of Shriners; Dillon Robinson, Virginian bartender; and Jason Deshner, Virginian door man.

The Council held discussion on various options and if the ordinance provides any leeway for Council.

A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to continue this item to the February 4, 2019 regular meeting. Staff requested Council to specify the information to be brought back, which included if Council has discretion in applying 6.60.020 H.1. and what the differences are between the different types of liquor licenses. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

East Hansen Sidewalk Design. Larry Pardee made introductory remarks. Tyler Sinclair and Brian Lenz made staff comment on options and issues related to adding a sidewalk to Hansen Avenue between Cache Street and Redmond Street.

Public comment was given by Bob Lenz, Anne Cresswell, Steve Harrington, and Tom Fay, all residents on Hansen Street.

A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to direct staff to begin public outreach by contacting the neighborhood and the community regarding design of the sidewalk for East Hansen Avenue between Cache Street and Redmond Street, to look at different designs that incorporate different buffer widths and bring it back for subsequent Council discussion about timing and how it fits in the Capital Improvement Plan and the Department of Public Works workload. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.
