

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

FEBRUARY 19, 2019

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall at 150 East Pearl at 3:00 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

MAYOR: Pete Muldoon.

COUNCIL: Hailey Morton Levinson, Jim Stanford, Arne Jorgensen, and Jonathan Schechter.

STAFF: Larry Pardee, Roxanne Robinson, Audrey Cohen-Davis, Lea Colasuonno, Floren Poliseo, Brian Lenz, Paul Anthony, and Sandy Birdyshaw.

Mayor Muldoon introduced new Town employee Miriam Kellams as information coordinator for the Police Department.

Stormwater Overview. Floren Poliseo made staff comment on Jackson's existing stormwater management recommendations and planning documents, work done so far through master and management plans, and issues and opportunities available for updating stormwater programming. Public comment was given by Len Carlman, Jared Becker of Snake River Fund, and Max Ludington.

A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to direct staff to continue to work with Council as needed to provide more information upon request, progress toward a scope or outline for a Town of Jackson Stormwater Management Plan and determine a course of action at a date yet to be determined, as the plan takes shape and funding is identified. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Small Cell Wireless Discussion. Paul Anthony and Lea Colasuonno made staff comment on how new federal regulations will impact local wireless facilities within the Town and proposed proceeding with ordinances and standards for managing the development of these facilities. The Council held discussion on regulations, technology, and moving forward with local regulations.

A motion was made by Hailey Morton Levinson and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to draft regulations and ordinances to manage small cell wireless applications and the associated development in the Town and present them at a future Council meeting. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed 4-1 in favor with Stanford opposed. The motion carried.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded Hailey Morton Levinson to adjourn to executive session to consider matters concerning litigation to which the governing body is a party or proposed litigation to which the governing body may be a party in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(iii).
