First, I would like to express my appreciation for the hard work you all doing during this pandemic. It is crucial to have leaders can be the first, the right, the credible to manage an emergency, promoting actions, expressing empathy, and showing respect to all community members.

I am very interested in serving as a member on the Board of Health because I am passionate about taking care of others, and I believe we should be part of actions that can support the best for the collective when we have the opportunity.

In 2012, I moved to Jackson from Sao Paulo, Brazil, city where I spent my whole life, as the 4th child on a middle class Italian – Portuguese family. I graduated Bachelor in Nutrition Science at the Catholic University of Campinas – Sao Paulo, became a specialist in Food Safety Systems, at SENAI (Serviço Nacional de Aprendizagem Industrial - National Service of Industrial Learning), and Nutritional Therapy on the Non-Transmissible Chronic Diseases, such as Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases, Obesity, and others, at Albert Einstein Institute of Education and Research - Health Education Center.

I worked as Health & Food Safety Senior Consultant, developing, implementing, and managing their Food Safety Systems, also as Clinical Nutritionist, treating patients with chronic diseases on my clinic and primary, secondary and tertiary levels in private hospitals.

During my professional career in Sao Paulo, I served as a Nutritionist, member of a multi-professional board, supporting projects to combat childhood malnutrition on “under the poverty line” communities. I also volunteered for a publishing company to promote Health and Wellness for Seniors, teaching healthy recipes, and answering questions about nutrition in workshops.

I moved to the United States because I meet an amazing person, Mike, and we decided to start a family together. On the first two years living in Jackson, I dedicated 100% of my time to adapt myself and my two kids to a new life. We learned the language, culture, make friends, and understood how to enjoy all fun things to do in the valley and around the State.

In 2015, I started my own business, a small private concierge to assist Brazilians to visit Jackson on the ski season. In April 2019, I turned my concierge to a Travel Agency & Tour Operator, to attend Brazilians and Americans clients interesting to travel worldwide with tailor-made travel services.

Since 2012, I being part of our community in different ways, as a mom, wife, entrepreneur, woman, volunteer, donor, and others. I was a mentor for young entrepreneur women on Womomentum non - profit, support my husband in Cheyenne, representing our county, as part of the Legislators Spouses Group developing social actions to help Wyomingites vulnerable to hunger, malnutrition, and in inequality.

In November 2019, I became a board member on the Wyoming Hunger Initiative, the WY First Lady Jennie Gordon initiative to eradicate childhood hunger on our State.
