EMERGENCY TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS - **UNAPPROVED**

JULY 2, 2020

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in an emergency session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall located at 150 East Pearl at 5:00 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: *In-person*: Mayor Pete Muldoon. *via Webex*: Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, and Jonathan Schechter. Jim Stanford was absent.

STAFF: Roxanne Robinson, Tyler Sinclair, Lea Colasuonno, Roger Schulz, Jason Wright, Susan Scarlata, and Sandy Birdyshaw.

Mayor Muldoon stated the purpose of this meeting was to consider an emergency ordinance to require the wearing of face masks. Dr. Riddell had submitted a public health order to the State this week which has not been signed. Today's meeting was to consider directing the Town Attorney to prepare an Ordinance and set a meeting tomorrow at 3:00 p.m. to review the ordinance. Public comment would be taken tomorrow when the ordinance was discussed.

A motion was made by Hailey Morton Levinson and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct the staff to draft an ordinance reflecting the health order and resolution requiring the wearing of masks in public places.

The Council held further discussion. Lea Colasuonno made staff comment.

Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0-1 in favor, with Stanford absent. The motion carried.

The Council discussed scheduling a Special Meeting tomorrow, July 3, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. unless a County Health Order was signed before then.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Hailey Morton Levinson and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to adjourn. The vote showed 4-0-1 in favor, with Stanford absent. The motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 5:14 p.m. minutes:spb
