

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

JUNE 15, 2020

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in special workshop session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall at 150 East Pearl at 1:03 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: *In-person*: Mayor Pete Muldoon. *via Webex*: Vice-Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, Jonathan Schechter, and Jim Stanford

Town Budget Discussion. Larry Pardee and Tyler Sinclair facilitated discussion on changes to the budget for Housing, Fire Fund 11 and 13, Parks and Recreation Operations; property insurance; and START ski pass/multimodal transportation program. The Administrator to the County Commissioners, Alysa Watkins, made comment on the Fire/EMS budget. Parks and Recreation Director Steve Ashworth made comment. The Parks Maintenance Shop change orders were discussed. Roxanne Robinson made staff comment.

Snow King Conditional Use Permits (CUPs) and Lease Agreement Overview. Tyler Sinclair made comment on the Conditional Use Permit requested by Snow King. Item A – Gondola, Cougar Lift, and Lighting: An Outdoor Recreation CUP to locate and operate a gondola facility at the base of Snow King Resort in Phil Baux Park at 100 E. Snow King Avenue in the general location of the existing Cougar lift with additional lighting for night skiing operations. The Cougar lift was proposed to be relocated approximately 250’ uphill from its current location. Item B – Zip Line: An Outdoor Recreation CUP to locate and operate a zip line facility on Snow King Resort property with a takeoff point located on Lot 59, Grand View Lodges, Third Addition, and a landing pedestal at 402 East Snow King Avenue adjacent to the Snow King Hotel and Rafferty Center. Item C – Pump House: A Utility Facility CUP to locate a snow-making pump house and related infrastructure across the lot lines of 10 E Snow King Avenue and 90 E Snow King Avenue behind the Snow King Sports & Event Center. Steve Ashworth made comment regarding the Parks and Recreation Board related comments. Ryan Stanley with Snow King made a presentation of the proposals.

Kids Bike Park Update. Brian Schilling provided an update on the Blair Drive Kid’s Bike Park. Discussion was held. Lea Colasuonno made staff comment. Public was given by John Graham and Katherine Dowson.

A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to continue this item to another council meeting. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Draft Release of Water & Sewer Systems Capacity Study. This item was not heard. A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to continue this item to a future workshop. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to adjourn to executive session to consider the selection of a site or the purchase of real estate when the publicity regarding the consideration would cause a likelihood of an increase in price in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(vii).
