The Jackson Town Council met in special session in the Town Council Chambers located at in Town Hall at 150 East Pearl Avenue at 2:34 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

MAYOR: Pete Muldoon.

COUNCIL: Arne Jorgensen, Jim Stanford, and Jonathan Schechter. Hailey Morton Levinson was absent.

STAFF: Sandy Birdyshaw, Public Health Director Jodie Pond and current members of the Board of Health.

The Council held a brief discussion with Jodie Pond and member of the Board of Health.

Interviews for Teton District Board of Health. In December 2018 the Teton County Board of County Commissioners passed a resolution increasing the number of members on the Teton District Board of Health and allowing any municipality in the County to participate and appoint one member. In February 2019, the Town Council passed a resolution agreeing to participate in the board and advertised for letters of interest. Today, J. J.
