

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

NOVEMBER 16, 2020

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall at 150 East Pearl at 3:02 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: *In-person*: none. *via Zoom*: Mayor Pete Muldoon, Vice-Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, Jim Stanford, and Jonathan Schechter.

Update to Jackson Municipal Code Title 13 Utilities Water and Sewer Rates. Johnny Ziem made staff comment that the purpose of the amendment to Jackson Municipal Code Title 13, was to update sewer and water rates and fees. Proposed amendments included an alternative structure for one-time sewer and water capacity fees, an alternative structure for water rates and sewer rates, a have the new rates be effective July 1, 2021, and a 3 Creek Capital Replacement Fee Adjustment.

A motion was made by Hailey Morton Levinson and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to approve the draft amendments to Title 13 and direct staff to bring back the draft ordinance as amended for first reading on the December 7, 2020, Regular meeting of the Jackson Town Council. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Budget Check-In. Larry Pardee provided an update and year-to-date overview of the Fiscal Year 2021 budget revenues and expenditures, the priority driven budget, frozen positions, and future funding of local government options including property tax, lodging tax, enterprise fund, fees, parking and exactions. Discussion was held. Floren Poliseo and Lea Colasuonno made staff comment.

A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to bring back for the Council's consideration a property tax up to 8 mils, enterprise fund, updated development fees, and managed parking. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to adjourn.

Jim Stanford made comment on the season snowplow driver. Arne Jorgensen made comment. Johnny Ziem made staff comment.

The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 4:46 P.M.
