

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

DECEMBER 16, 2020

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in special session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall located at 150 East Pearl at 10:03 A.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: *In-person*: None. *via Zoom*: Mayor Pete Muldoon, Arne Jorgensen, and Jonathan Schechter. Hailey Morton Levinson joined at 10:06 a.m. and Jim Stanford joined at 10:15 a.m.

Ordinances. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to read the Ordinance in short title. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Ordinance U: An Ordinance Amending and Reenacting Jackson Municipal Code Sections 13.04 and 13.08 Regarding Water and Wastewater Rates, Fees, and Costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to approve Ordinance U at second reading. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Review of Priority-based Budget 39 Programs. Larry Pardee and Tyler Sinclair made comment on why the Town moved to a priority-based budget and programs were reviewed. April Norton and Michelle Weber made staff comment. Housing and police patrol programs were discussed.

Executive Session. At 12:04 p.m., A motion was made by Hailey Morton Levinson and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to recess the meeting to executive session to consider matters concerning litigation to which the governing body is a party or proposed litigation to which the governing body may be a party in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(iii). Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

The meeting recessed at 12:04 p.m. and reconvened at 2:03 p.m. Jim Stanford joined at 2:05 p.m.

Review of Priority-based Budget 39 Programs. Tyler Sinclair continued facilitating the discussion on programs, including health and human services, public engagement, special events, bus service, and service to Teton Village and snow removal.

A motion was made by Pete Muldoon and seconded by Jim Stanford to direct the Town Manager to bring back a proposal to eliminate the following activities from the Police Department and to refrain from adding new duties to the Police Department without the approval of the Town Council and those activities are teaching T.I.P.S., camp post guard, coffee with a cop, the canine program, the active shooter training, hunter safety courses and bank robbery seminars.

Jim Stanford, Arne Jorgensen, Hailey Morton Levinson, Jonathan Schechter, Pete Muldoon, and Jim Stanford made comment. Lea Colasuonno made staff comment.

Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed Muldoon in favor and Morton Levinson, Jorgensen, Stanford, and Schechter opposed. The motion failed.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Jim Stanford and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to adjourn the meeting. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 4:10 p.m. minutes:spb/crp
