

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

April 19, 2021

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in special workshop session in the Town Hall Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 2:00 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: *In-person*: None. *via Zoom*: Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, Jessica Sell Chambers, and Jim Rooks. Jonathan Schechter joined at 2:03 p.m.

The Mayor introduced Annette Langley our new Planning Coordinator.

Director Updates. Floren Poliseo, Paul Anthony, Zolo, and Brady Hansen provided brief updates from their departments.

Council Priority and Staff Capacity Check-In. Tyler Sinclair provided an overview of Council's priorities identified at the 2021 Town Council Retreat, work plan projects, and next steps.

The Council held discussion and asked questions of staff.

A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to amend the Project Descriptions as discussed today. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 5-0 in favor and the motion carried.

Ordinance 473 and LDR Definition of Family. Tyler Sinclair made staff comment regarding the definition of family in the Town's Land Development Regulations and the 1993 Ordinance Number 473.

Public comment was given by Mark Houser, Maddie Johnson, Ash Hermanowski, Clare Stumpf, Ivan Jimenez, Robert Mann, and Tim Fram.

The Council held discussion.

Councilor Jorgensen's connection was dropped from the meeting at 4:18 and rejoined at 4:24 p.m.

A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to move to amend the Text of the Land Development Regulations, definition of family as described in the staff report consistent with Definition of Family - Option 3 and Occupancy Limit – Option 2.

Councilor Chambers asked to separate the motion.

A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to move to amend the Text of the Land Development Regulations, definition of family as described in the staff report consistent with Definition of Family - Option 3 [*Family Option 3 – Repeal any Definition of Family*]. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 5-0 in favor and the motion carried.

A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to move to amend the Text of the Land Development Regulations, consistent with Definition of Occupancy Limit – Option 2 [*Occupancy Option 2: Amend the LDRs to include maximum occupancy restrictions*]. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 4-1 in favor with Chambers opposed. The motion carried.

Municipal Code Title 6 Updates Related to 2021 Legislation. This item was not heard. A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Hailey Morton Levinson to continue Title 6 to the next appropriate meeting. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 4-1 in favor with Chambers opposed. The motion carried.

Rancher Street Complete Street Conceptual Design. Johnny Ziem presented a series of complete street conceptual designs related to the Rancher Street Complete Street Project from East Broadway Ave to Hansen Avenue.

Public comment was given by Lea Bonnecaze, Robert Mann, Connie Bergmann, Judd Grossman,

A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to continue the Rancher Street item to next appropriate meeting as determined by the Mayor. The Mayor called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Jessica Chambers and seconded by Jim Rooks to adjourn the meeting. The Mayor called for the vote. The vote showed 5-0 in favor and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 5:12 p.m. minutes:spb
