

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

July 19, 2021

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop session in the Town Hall Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 3:00 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Downtown Bike Lane Connectivity. Brian Schilling made staff comment. Katherine Dowson made public comment. The vote showed 3-0 in favor and the motion carried.

Public Private Partnership Fee Waiver. Tyler Sinclair and April Norton made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Jessica Sell Chambers to direct staff to draft and/or revise applicable Town resolutions or Cooperative Agreements to adjust the Town Fee Waiver Policy for 100% deed restricted housing developments and the associated Planning, Building, Engineering and Utility fees as recommended by staff in this staff report dated July 19, 2021, and as discussed at this meeting. Vice Mayor Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed 3-0 in favor and the motion carried.

Downtown Pedestrian Project. Johnny Ziem made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Anna Olson, Cedar Davis and Jay Varley made public comment. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Jessica Sell Chambers to approve the Downtown Pedestrian Improvement Project conceptual plans as amended and direct staff to take the concept to final design under the suggestions and recommendations discussed today.
