

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

September 20, 2021

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in a regular workshop session at 3:00 P.M. This meeting was held through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Director Updates. Darren Brugmann, Lea Colasuonno, Roxanne Robinson, and Michelle Weber provided department updates.

Title 15 Buildings and Construction Code Update. Tyler Sinclair and Kelly Sluder made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Item 1. A motion was made by Jessica Sell Chambers and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to revise the Contractor Licensing portion of Title 15 Buildings and Construction of the Jackson Municipal Code consistent with Alternative 2 described in this staff report, incorporating any changes thereto discussed today. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0 in favor and the motion carried. Item 2. A motion was made by Jessica Sell Chambers and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to revise Titles 5 and 15 of the Jackson Municipal Code and to bring back a full revised draft thereof at a future meeting 1) with the policy changes as presented in the June 21 staff report, and as directed today, including any further minor amendments identified by staff and incorporating any changes thereto discussed on June 21 and today and 2) with a full update to the Titles for technical matters as identified by staff. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0 in favor and the motion carried.

Early Childhood Education. Susan Scarlata and Larry Pardee made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff.
