September 27, 2021

The Jackson Town Council met in special session for a retreat held virtually through the Zoom platform at 8:32 a.m. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Welcome/Agenda Overview. Heather Bergman reviewed the agenda and the purpose of various agenda items listed.
