

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

August 19, 2021

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in a special meeting at 10:04 A.M. This meeting was held through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: *In-person:* None. *via Zoom:* Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, and Jessica Sell Chambers. Jonathan Schechter and Jim Rooks were absent.

Planning Commission/Board of Adjustments Interviews. Mayor Morton Levinson announced that John Hoover withdrew his letter of interest. Council held interviews with Thomas Smits, Christie Schutt, and Rachael Stewart.

Executive Session. A motion was made by Jessica Sell Chambers and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to recess to an executive session at 10:48 a.m. to discuss personnel matters in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(iii).
