

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

November 15, 2021

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in a regular workshop session at 3:00 P.M. This meeting was held virtually through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Public Art Ordinance Discussion. Tyler Sinclair made staff comment. Carrie Geraci made comment on behalf of the applicant. Council held discussion with staff and the applicant. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Jessica Sell Chambers to direct staff to prepare a Percent for Art ordinance as described in the November 15, 2021 staff report as well as incorporating comments made by councilmembers during discussion for Council consideration as soon as practicable, including options to provide for the suspension of the ordinance in the event of unavailable funding, maintenance funds, and a requirement for private organizations to incorporate public art in their buildings. Vice Mayor Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0 in favor with Morton Levinson absent and the motion carried.

Title 10 Vehicles and Traffic. Lea Colasuonno made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Tim Fram made public comment. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jessica Sell Chambers to direct staff to 1) revise Title 10 of the Jackson Municipal Code with the policy recommendations presented in the staff report; 2) revise the Title for technical matters identified by staff; and 3) bring back a full revised draft of the Title for Council consideration at a future meeting. Vice Mayor Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0 in favor with Morton Levinson absent and the motion carried.

Stable and Transitional Neighborhood Presentation and Public Comment. Tyler Sinclair made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Judd Grossman, Kevin Cochary, Perri Stern, Michael Stern, Allen Symonds, Sandy Shuptrine, Tim Fram, Julien Hass, Jason Wright, Kyle Fallor, Leslie Steen, Stefania Fram, Anna Kerr, Katy Hollbacher, Chris Dickie, Wes Gardner, Mike Yin, Serese Kudar, Claire Stumpf, and Chris Lee made public comment. A motion was made by Jessica Sell Chambers and seconded by Jim Rooks to continue this item until the December 6, 2021 regular meeting. Vice Mayor Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0 in favor with Morton Levinson absent and the motion carried.
