

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

JANUARY 18, 2022

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in a regular workshop at 1:30 PM. This meeting was held virtually through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call, the following were found to be present:

Bear Conflict Mitigation. Tyler Sinclair, Ryan Hostetter, and Lea Colasuonno made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to proceed with implementation steps necessary to reduce bear and other wildlife conflicts in the Town of Jackson as provided in Alternatives 1, 2, and 3 in the staff report dated January 18, 2022 and as discussed by Council at the meeting. Rec Center Expansion Update. Steve Ashworth made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. No action was taken.
