 - ii. Optimizing land use for affordable homes:
 - iii. Ensuring access and Developing communities of opportunity – beyond building homes, building community that includes childcare, green-space, etc.
 - iv. Increasing access to credit: Expanding accessibility of programs.
- b. Consider intersectionality and ways to reach people with a wide variety of marginalized identities.
- c. Community Needs Assessment in 2019: 51.4% of respondents weren't familiar with Habitat. People were already paying high rents back then and facing safety and structural issues.
