

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

MAY 9, 2022

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in special workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 9:00 A.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: *In-person*: Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, Jim Rooks, and Jonathan Schechter. Jessica Sell Chambers was absent.

Budget Discussion. Larry Pardee, Kelly Thompson, Floren Poliseo, Tyler Sinclair, Michelle Weber, and Steve Ashworth made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff.

A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jim Rooks to direct staff to decrease funding for the budget item allocated to Stilson Transit Center and Highway 390 signal prioritization in the amount of roughly \$1.3 million. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Council recessed at 11:04am and reconvened at 11:14am.

Discussion continued. There was no public comment.

A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to adjust funding for council priorities and staff updates in the amount of \$628,717, as presented during the special workshop. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0 in favor with Jessica Sell Chambers absent and the motion carried.
