SEPTEMBER 19, 2022

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 1:30 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: Vice Mayor Arne Jorgensen, Jim Rooks, Jonathan Schechter, and Jessica Sell Chambers. Mayor Morton Levinson joined at 1:41 p.m.

Director Updates. Roxanne Robinson and Zolo gave updates on behalf of the Personnel and IT Departments, respectively.

A motion was made by Jessica Sell Chambers and seconded by Jim Rooks to present the items in the following order: Short Term Rentals, Pathway Safety and E-Bike Usage, Wastewater Treatment Plant Technical Review Update, and Council’s Work Plan Review. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

- 5) Item 8 – Guidelines and Etiquette Signage

And approve the following contingent upon funding:

- 6) Item 7 – Pavement surfacing and color

Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 4-0 in favor with Sell Chambers absent and the motion carried.

Wastewater Treatment Plant Technical Review Update. This item was continued to the Regular Town Council Meeting in the evening.

Council’s Work Plan Review. This item was continued to the next available workshop.
