

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

NOVEMBER 21, 2022

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 1:30 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, Jim Rooks, Jonathan Schechter, and Jessica Sell Chambers.

Director Updates. Paul Anthony, Steve Jellie, and Michelle Weber gave updates on behalf of the Planning, Fire/EMS, and Police Departments, respectively. Council held discussion with staff.

Winter Service Update. Tyler Sinclair provided Council with an update regarding level of winter service. Council held discussion with staff.

Town Sustainability Plan - *Continued*. Tanya Anderson made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Reade Dornan, Grant Gallaher, Emma, Miles Finley, Nicole Milbitz, and Candra Day made public comment. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to approve the priorities of ecosystem stewardship, climate stewardship, and climate resiliency and the overarching goals and guiding questions as written in the November 21, 2022 staff report for a Hybrid Municipal and Community-wide Town of Jackson Sustainability Plan that includes Scope 1, Scope 2, and Scope 3 emissions.

Council recessed from 2:25pm and reconvened at 3:32pm.

Town Manager Next Steps Check-in. Tyler Sinclair made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jessica Sell Chambers to direct staff to bring back a revised job description, as discussed during the workshop, and evaluation metrics at the earliest convenience. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Structural Water Rate Adjustment. Johnny Ziem and Tanya Anderson made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jessica Sell Chambers to direct staff to create a draft update to the water rates in Title 13 of the Jackson Municipal Code as discussed in the November 21, 2022, staff report that includes:

- 1. An expansion of the tiered rate system for all In-Town residential water customers.
- 2. An expansion of the tiered rate system for all 3 Creek residential and irrigation customers.

Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.
