

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

MARCH 20, 2023

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 1:30 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Mayor Morton Levinson introduced Marinda Elkins, Transit Supervisor/Dispatcher.

Willow Street Safe Routes/Bollard Discussion. Brian Schilling made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Jim Wallace, Audra Dean, Rick Howe, Ted Kyle, Amy Ringholz, Ashley Quinn, Sam Petri, Katie Bernasik, Katherine Dowson, Earl Mondel, Frank Page, Chaney Hankins, Linore Wallace made public comment. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jessica Sell Chambers to approve the Willow Street and Snow King Avenue Safe Routes Project for 2023 in the same layout as 2022. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to prepare a staff report to consider the following additional traffic and street changes:

- 1) 4-way stop at the intersection of Snow King Avenue and Willow Street

Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed 3-2 with Mayor Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, and Jim Rooks in favor, and Jessica Sell Chambers and Jonathan Schechter opposed.

Parklet and Flex Plan for Summer 2023. Aaron Carrillo and Susan Scarlata made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to direct staff to implement a Parklet program for the summer of 2023 with a flat rate fee structure and, at minimum, the operational requirements as presented in this staff report and direct staff to bring back an ordinance for Council review at a future Council meeting. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Waste Water Treatment Plant Capital and Operational Improvements. Floren Poliseo made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment. No motion was made.

Teton County Water Quality Master Plan Update. No discussion.
