

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

JULY 17, 2023

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 1:30 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: Mayor Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, Jonathan Schechter, and Jim Rooks. Jessica Sell Chambers was absent.

STAFF: Tyler Sinclair, Roxanne Robinson, Floren Poliseo, Susan Scarlata, and Riley Taylor.

Regular Meeting Schedule. Roxanne Robinson and Lea Colasuonno made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jim Rooks to direct staff to bring forward an ordinance for first reading at the August 7, 2023 Town Council meeting that changes rescheduled meetings due to holidays to the following Monday, changes the regular JIMs to 1:30 PM, and that adds regular meetings at 9AM on specific Tuesdays in April and May of each year as proposed. The motion was repealed.

A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to repeal the current ordinances setting Council meeting times, amend the rules and regulations to remove the current Council meeting times in the Rules and Procedures, and bring forward a ordinance for first reading at the October 2 Town Council meeting that changes rescheduled meetings due to holidays to the following Monday, changes the regular JIMs to 1:30pm, and that adds regular meetings at 9:00am on specific Tuesdays in April and May of each year as discussed today. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Censure Policy Scoping Report. Lea Colasuonno made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to research and present censure policy and ordinances, as appropriate, at a future Council meeting. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Indoor Vaping Scoping Report. Lea Colasuonno made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to place this initiative on the Potential Initiative list for future consideration. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Matters from Mayor and Council.

Mountain Towns 2030 Climate Solutions Summit and Fall CAST Meeting. Council held discussion. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to approve travel for any Councilmember wishing to attend the Mountain Towns 2030 Climate Solutions Summit and Fall CAST Meeting. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Council Priorities and Upcoming Agendas. Tyler Sinclair and Roxanne Robinson made staff comment. Council reviewed the 2-year workplan and Potential Initiative (PI) list with staff. No motion was made.
