

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

OCTOBER 16, 2023

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers, located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 1:30 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, and Jim Rooks. Jonathan Schechter joined at 1:39pm. Jessica Sell Chambers was absent.

STAFF: Tyler Sinclair, Roxanne Robinson, Lea Colasuonno, Johnny Ziem, Paul Anthony, Russ Ruschill, Tanya Anderson, Susan Scarlata, and Riley Taylor.

Water and Sewer Rate Amendments. Johnny Ziem, Lea Colasuonno, and Brian Lenz made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment. A motion was made by Arne Jorgensen and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to approve a commencement date for the Town of Jackson new utility rate structure on January 1, 2024, and direct staff to present an ordinance for first reading at a future Council meeting. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Censure Policy. Lea Colasuonno made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to present appropriate ordinance(s) and additions to the Council Rules and Procedures for censure at a future Council meeting. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Stormwater Management Program Status Update. Floren Poliseo made staff comment. Aaron Murray and Heather Williams made comment on behalf of the consultant. Council held discussion with staff. A motion was made by Jim Rooks and seconded by Arne Jorgensen to approve the proposed Stormwater Management Program Vision Statement and Goals and direct staff to bring policy questions related to the project back to Council at a future meeting. A friendly amendment was made by Jim Rooks and approved by Arne Jorgensen to approve the proposed Stormwater Management Program Vision Statement and Goals *as discussed today* and direct staff to bring policy questions related to the project back to Council at a future meeting. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote on the amended motion. The vote showed 3-1 with Mayor Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, and Jim Rooks in favor and Jonathan Schechter opposed. The motion carried.
