

## TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

NOVEMBER 13, 2023

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in special workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers, located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 1:30 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: Mayor Pro Tempore Arne Jorgensen, Jonathan Schechter, Jim Rooks and Jessica Sell Chambers. Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson was absent.

STAFF: Tyler Sinclair, Roxanne Robinson, Lea Colasuonno, Floren Poliseo, Paul Anthony, Katelyn Page, Michelle Weber, Brian Schilling, Tanya Anderson, and Riley Taylor.

**Required Bicycle Parking (P23-016).** Katelyn Page, Brian Schilling, and Paul Anthony made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Tyler Sinclair made staff comment. There was no public comment. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Jim Rooks to direct staff to prepare Ordinance X for LDR Text Amendment P23-016 as directed by Council regarding fees-in-lieu and based upon the findings presented in the staff report, the departmental reviews, and subject to this staff report dated November 13, 2023, and present that ordinance for first reading at a date to be determined. Mayor Pro Tempore Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Council recessed at 2:45p.m. and reconvened at 2:50p.m.

**Re-Evaluation of Large Building/2:1 Workforce Bonus (P23-180).** Paul Anthony made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment. A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tempore Jorgensen and seconded by Jonathan Schechter to direct staff to review the same information with the Planning Commission and Design Review Committee and continue discussion of this item to a future Council workshop. Discussion continue. Mayor Pro Tempore Jorgensen withdrew his motion. Jonathan Schechter consented to the withdrawal.

A new motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Jim Rooks to continue this item to a future Town Council workshop and direct staff to address the additional information requested by Council at the meeting, and direct staff to present the same information to the Planning Commission and Design Review Committee for input prior to future consideration by Council. Mayor Pro Tempore Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed 3-1 with Mayor Pro Tempore Jorgensen, Jonathan Schechter, and Jim Rooks in favor and Jessica Sell Chambers opposed. The motion carried.

**Council Priorities and Upcoming Agendas.** Council discussed parking. Jim Rooks added, and Jessica Sell Chambers seconded the addition, the topic of “all things parking” to the Potential Initiative (PI) list. Specifically, Councilman Rooks would like to begin work on Phases 3 and 4 of a previously established parking workplan.

Council discussed the budget. Jonathan Schechter added the topic of “long-term budget structure” to the Potential Initiative (PI) List.

Jessica Sell Chambers left the meeting at 4:49p.m.

Tyler Sinclair reviewed the rest of Council’s 2023 Work Plan and upcoming agendas. Council held discussion with staff.

**Adjourn.** A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Jim Rooks to adjourn. Mayor Pro Tempore Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried. The workshop adjourned at 4:57 p.m. Minutes: rt.
