

**JOINT INFORMATION PROCEEDINGS
TOWN COUNCIL AND BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING**

MARCH 18, 2024

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council and the Teton County Board of County Commissioners met in a special joint information meeting (JIM) at 11:03 a.m. in the County Commission Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. This meeting was held in-person. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

TOWN COUNCIL: Mayor Hailey Morton Levinson, Arne Jorgensen, and Jessica Sell Chambers. Jim Rooks was absent. *Via Zoom:* Jonathan Schechter.

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS: Chairman Luther Propst, Natalia Macker, Mark Newcomb, and Wes Gardner. Greg Epstein was absent.

START Board Interviews. The Board and the Town Council interviewed the following candidates for the START Board:

Executive Session. On behalf of the County, a motion was made by Commissioner Macker and seconded by Commissioner Gardner to enter executive session pursuant to Wyoming Statute §16-4-405(a)(ii) to consider appointments to volunteer boards, specifically the appointment of a board member as a public officer. Chair Propst called for the vote. The vote showed four in favor and the motion carried 4-0.

On behalf of the Town, a motion was made by Councilmember Jorgensen and seconded by Councilmember Sell Chambers to enter executive session pursuant to Wyoming Statute §16-4-405(a)(ii) to consider appointments to volunteer boards, specifically the appointment of a board member as a public officer. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed four in favor and the motion carried 4-0 for the Town.

Chair Propst called for the vote. The vote showed four in favor and the motion carried 4-0 for the County.

On behalf of the Town, a motion was made by Councilmember Sell Chambers and seconded by Councilmember Jorgensen to appoint William Monroe and Kevin Regan to the START Board for 3-year terms expiring December 31, 2026. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed four in favor and the motion carried 4-0 for the Town.

Adjourn. On behalf of the Town, a motion was made by Councilmember Jorgensen and seconded by Councilmember Sell Chambers to adjourn. Mayor Morton Levinson called for the vote. The vote showed four in favor and the motion carried 4-0. The Town adjourned at 11:34 a.m. The County Commission continued their regularly scheduled meeting.
