

**JOINT PROCEEDINGS
TOWN COUNCIL AND BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING**

MAY 5, 2025

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council and the Teton County Board of County Commissioners met in a regular joint meeting (JM) at 1:30 p.m. in the Town Council Chambers located at 150 East Pearl Avenue in Jackson. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:
