The Jackson Town Council met in a special meeting in the Town Hall Council Chambers, located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 8:00 A.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Letter to Federal Delegation on Potential Federal Government Shutdown. Rick Howe from the Jackson Hole Chamber of Commerce made public comment. Council held discussion. A motion was made by Jonathan Schechter and seconded by Alyson Spery to approve the letter to the Wyoming Federal delegation regarding the federal government shutdown as discussed today, subject to minor changes by staff. Mayor Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed 2-1 with Mayor Jorgensen and Alyson Spery in favor and Jonathan Schechter opposed. The motion carried.
