STATEMENT/PURPOSE

The purpose of this item is to allow time for the Town Council and County Commission to interview applicants, hold an executive session (if necessary), and make appointments to fill vacancies and/or expiring seats on the Jackson Hole Airport Board, Energy Conservation Works Board, Housing Supply Board, Parks and Recreation Board, and Pathways Taskforce.

BACKGROUND/ALTERNATIVES

Staff re-advertised for the Airport Board vacancy as directed on January 5. Teton County received two new applications by the deadline, in addition to the three applications that remain on file from the initial advertising period and interviews held in December. There are now five applicants, combined, to consider for one vacancy/expiring term on the Jackson Hole Airport Board. There are five applicants for one vacancy on Energy Conservation Works. This vacancy is the result of a resignation; therefore, the term is a partial term expiring this June. There were four applicants for two vacancies/expiring terms on the Housing Supply Board, three applicants for two vacancies/expiring on the Parks & Recreation Board, and one applicant for three vacancies/expiring terms on the Pathways Taskforce. There were not enough applicants to fill all vacancies on the Pathways Taskforce. This board will require further recruitment efforts.

Jackson Hole Airport Board

Pursuant to the Jackson and Teton County Agreement Regarding the Jackson Hole Airport Board, the Board shall have five (5) members, all of whom shall be qualified electors of Teton County and shall be jointly appointed by the Teton County Commission and Jackson Town Council to serve 5-year, staggered terms. - Approving the annual budget and changes to user fees, rates and other charges.
- Operating under a Joint Powers Agreement (Town + County) and under Wyoming law.
- Ensuring that the airport operates as a financially self-sufficient enterprise.

2. Compliance, Risk Management and Stewardship

- Ensuring compliance with applicable federal/state regulations.
- Environmental stewardship and community impact issues.
- Custodian of the airport's infrastructure, agreements, and long term capital planning.

3. Policy Setting and Oversight of Management

- Hiring and/or supervising the Executive Director and overseeing the staff's performance.
- Establishing policy and broader direction for airport operations.
- Selecting the officers from among board members.

4. Meeting Attendance, Public/Community Relations and Stakeholder Engagement

- Regular attendance at board meetings.
 - Engaging with the community, local governments,

and other stakeholders (such as NPS, airlines, and concessionaires) to represent the public interest of the airport.

- Ensuring transparency of records & reports.

5. Ethical and Fiduciary Responsibilities

- Acting in the public interest, avoiding all conflicts of interest, upholding trust.

- Ensuring the airport is operated for the benefit of the community, while balancing fiscal responsibility, safety, environmental stewardship, and service.

Why do you want to serve on this Board?

I believe that safe, affordable housing is a human right and that every person and family should have the freedom and opportunity to achieve their potential in this community, should they choose to, and not be forced out because they cannot afford housing. I am concerned that our Housing Supply Plan is not focusing enough on families and that moment-in-time surveys finding 1-2 person households comprise the "largest share" of those seeking housing may be a self-fulfilling prophecy of past policy. Also, what happens to these small households when they grow and want to raise their families here?

What are your qualifications for serving on this Board?

With more than 25 years of experience in the building industry that includes 16 in affordable housing, I have extensive experience with not only the technical aspects that go into creating constructable, healthy and efficient buildings, but also the politics and constraints of affordable projects. Funding challenges are real; I've worked on thousands of housing units (lowrise, midrise, single-family and multifamily) over my professional career and these are often the result of 10-20+ funding sources including tax credits, philanthropy, investors, volunteer sweat equity etc. However, financial hurdles shouldn't be an excuse to ignore opportunities to make better homes (e.g. energy efficiency and improved air

quality) that are in the long-term best interest for not only owners and tenants, but the community at large.

What experience and/or special training do you have that is pertinent to this Board's efforts?	Given my professional work that bridges the housing and energy efficiency/sustainability industries, I will bring a unique understanding of cost, constructability, and the influence of design-related decisions on long-term operations and maintenance costs. Lower Valley Energy is a critical stakeholder in ongoing electricity costs, and I'd be interested in bringing them into some discussions to inform the Supply Board's strategy and policy approaches. Through my 16 years running a small consulting business, and previous work at a non-profit, I bring other applicable skills and knowledge beyond technical building and industry expertise including grant and proposal writing, sales, marketing, and financials.
