JUNE 15, 2026

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in regular workshop in the Town Hall Council Chambers, located at 150 East Pearl in Jackson, at 1:30 P.M. This meeting was held in-person and through the Zoom platform. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

Announcements. Mayor Jorgensen introduced Thea Farrell, Planning Intern.

LDR Changes to Address Large Development Impacts (PM26-011). Paul Anthony made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. Michael Kudar made public comment. A motion was made by Alyson Sperry and seconded by Kevin Regan to continue the LDR changes presented today to the next available meeting. Mayor Jorgensen called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

Town Long Range Planning FY27 Work Plan (PM26-014). Paul Anthony, Alex Norton, and Ryan Hostetter made staff comment. Council held discussion with staff. There was no public comment.
